

**GENERAL GUIDELINES
CONCERNING THE NEW
AUTOMATED COLLECTION SYSTEM**

- Only the new waste collection cart will be picked up for residential waste disposal. There will be no other refuse collected.
- Domestic waste that is deposited into the waste collection bin needs to be bagged in a plastic bag and tied at the top.
- Any domestic waste that does not fit into the waste collection cart will not be picked up.
- The waste collection cart is the sole responsibility of the property owner.
- If a waste collection cart is stolen, lost, damaged or another cart is needed a replacement cart must be purchased from the Town.
- If an additional bin is needed at your residence, an additional monthly fee will be added to your utility account.(2011 Rate \$15.00)

THE NEW WASTE COLLECTION CARTS

Beginning in early July 2010 each residency in the Town of Raymond will receive a new 369L Waste Collection Cart. This will be picked up on the usual scheduled day for garbage collection by the town's new fully automated garbage truck. Some of the features of the new waste collection cart include:

1. An advanced lid hinge offering a tight seal that keeps pests and weather out and trash in.
2. Ergonomic handles that provide easy handling even when the cart is full.
3. 12 inch wheels that provide stability over uneven surfaces.



HAVING YOUR WASTE COLLECTION CART PICKED UP

Your waste collection cart will be picked up on your regular collection day

Please adhere to the following guidelines to ensure that your waste collection cart is picked up:

1. Place the cart on the curb or where there is no curb within ten feet of the travelled area of the street before 8:00 a.m. on your regular scheduled garbage pick up day.
2. Ensure that nothing is in front of the cart or directly behind it.
3. Ensure that the area within a one metre circumference of the cart is kept clear.
4. Place the cart so that the arrow on top of the cart is facing the street.
5. After pick up has occurred ensure that the cart is returned to your residence before 8:00 a.m.

the following day.

If the waste collection cart does not adhere to the guidelines outlined in this pamphlet it will not be picked up on that day or any other day of the week. It will only be picked up on the next scheduled collection day if it is in adherence to the guidelines outlined in this pamphlet.

Residential scheduled pickups that fall upon a Statutory holiday will be collected on the next business day.
