TOWN OF RAYMOND BYLAW NO. 1050-18

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF RAYMOND TO ESTABLISH AND DEFINE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS it is provided in Section 145 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, that Council may pass bylaws to establish council committees and define their functions;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to establish a council committee to assist Council with matters related to the beautification of the Town of Raymond;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RAYMOND, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

PART 1 - INTERPRETATION

1. This Bylaw may be referred as the "Beautification Committee Bylaw".

PART 2 - APPLICATION

2. This Bylaw applies to beautification related issues concerning the Town of Raymond.

PART 3 - DEFINITIONS

- 3. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) "Town" means the municipal corporation of the Town of Raymond or the area contained within the boundaries of the Town.
 - (b) "Committee" means the Beautification Committee established by this Bylaw.
 - (c) "Council" means the municipal council of the Town of Raymond.
 - (d) "Interested party" means an individual or group specifically invited by the Committee to attend a specified Committee meeting to address a specific item on the Committee's agenda.

PART 4 - MEMBERSHIP

- 4. The Committee shall consist of one Town Councillor and six (6) members at large.
- 5. (a) Annually, following Council Organizational Meeting, the Committee will designate by resolution one (1) member as Chair and one (1) member as Vice Chair.
 - (b) If a permanent vacancy of the Chair of the Committee occurs during the year, the Vice Chair will serve as Chair for the remainder of the vacating member's term.

- (c) In the case of a temporary absence of the Chair, the Vice Chair will fill the role of the Chair.
- 6. (a) The Committee shall meet, as required, at the call of the Chair.
 - (b) In the event that the Chair is unwilling or unable to call a meeting of the Committee, any member of Council may request that Council, by resolution, call a meeting of the Committee.
- 7. The Chair shall, in ensuring that the Committee fulfills its roles and responsibilities as defined in this Bylaw, undertake the following:
 - (a) Schedule and chair Committee meetings;
 - (b) Approve agendas for Committee meetings in consultation with administration;
 - (c) Sign minutes of the Committee proceedings along with the CAO;
 - (d) Liaise with administration; and
 - (e) Report to Council of behalf of the Committee.
- 8. The Committee Chair may invite, or accept requests from, interested parties to attend Committee meetings to make verbal presentations or to make written submissions to the Committee on a specific item on the Committee's agenda.
- 9. The Committee may establish sub-committees by motion to assist with beautification related issues. Administration will work with the Committee to draft terms of reference for each sub-committee that is established.
- 10. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to Council on town beautification related issues, including:
 - (a) Initiatives and programs that foster civic pride through town beautification.
 - (b) Improve the tidiness, appearance and visual appeal of neighbourhoods, parks, open spaces and streets.
 - (c) Environmental awareness and preservation of heritage and culture.
