### **Handi-Bus**

Nichole Terry met with council to discuss the current direction of the Handi-bus. Administration has been asked to develop a business case on options and a decision is to be made by September 2018.

### **Downtown Re-development**

Council tabled plans for a pop-up traffic circle on Broadway. Downtown development and community branding specialist, Roger Brooks, will be visiting Raymond in September to complete an assessment and development plan for the Raymond Downtown.

### **Councillor Robinson Resignation**

For personal reasons, Councillor Greg Robinson has resigned as a Town Councillor. As a result, Council assignments have shifted and new assignments can be found on Raymond.ca. A by-election will be held September 10, 2018. More information to come.

### **Health Unit**

Council approved renovations to begin that will convert the Raymond health unit to Town offices.

### **Public Participation Policy**

The Public Participation Policy was approved by council and will be posted on the Town website.

### **Raw Water**

Council approved a moratorium on new raw water service additions until a raw water master plan is complete.
