Oath of Office Councillor Stewart Foss was officially sworn in as a Raymond Town Councillor for the remainder of the term.

**Delegation
Kyle Stone** Kyle Stone spoke to council requesting council support of him accessing the RID's water line. Council will discuss this further in Council Committee Meeting.

Peace Officer Intern Josh Cram was sworn in as a Peace Officer Intern with the Ridge Regional Public Safety Services. He will be working alongside our peace officers for the next 8 months.

**Bylaw 1061-18
2nd & 3rd Reading** Second and third readings of Bylaw 1061-18 were passed by council. This amends the Land Use Bylaw to consider Cannabis Retail and Production regulations, prior to the federal legalization of Cannabis.

**Bylaw 1063-18
2nd & 3rd Reading** Second and third readings were passed for Bylaw 1063-18, a bylaw regarding the public consumption of Cannabis.

**Bylaw 1065-18
1st Reading** Council passed the first reading of Bylaw 1065-18. This bylaw redesignates property in Bridge Crossing from Urban Reserve, to Residential.

**Roger Brooks
Assessment Team** An assessment team comprised of 2 council members, 2 Tourism and Economic Development Committee members, and 2 Beautification Committee members, will be created to make assignments to prioritize and implement Roger Brooks recommendations.

**Westwind School
Division** Council passed a motion supporting the Westwind School Division's application for a new school in Raymond. The vote was as follows:
