## **Family Softball Tournament Rules**

1. Games played to 7 innings. No new inning is to start after the 1 hour time limit (this time will be extended to 1 hour 15 minutes for the semi-final and final games). Playoff games will play extra innings if needed.
2. Teams with a 10 run lead after the 4th inning will be declared the winner.
3. Each team must have a minimum of 2 Females and one player that is aged 40 or older in the outfield at all times. Females will bat in the 3rd and 7th positions.
4. Each team will have a maximum of 10 in the outfield. They may bat more than 10 in their lineup, but if batter is unable to bat and no substitute can be provided, missing batter will result in an out.
5. Each team must have 4 outfielders behind the outfield line when a female is up to bat.
6. Games are self umped. Batting team will provide the ump while they are at bat.
7. ZERO TOLERANCE - Swearing directly at another player, Displaying disrespectful or threatening behaviour, Intentionally pushing, shoving, or fighting will result in immediate removal of the player from the tournament.
8. This is a wooden bat tournament, all batters must use a provided bat. There will be specified balls to pitch to female batters. Females may use a metal bat, but that same bat must be made available to the other team to use as well.
9. All players must be a minimum of 14 year old. Pinch runners are available once a batter reaches 1st base.
10. Each team will be awarded 3 pts for a win, 2 pt for a tie and 0 pts for a loss. Teams will be ranked after pool play will be seeded in one of the semi-finals.
11. Tie breaker will be determined between 2 teams by head to head game between tied teams. 2nd tiebreaker be total runs for and against (differential) throughout round robin play (max 10 per game). 3rd will be fewest runs Against total, 4th will be total runs scored and if still tied, a coin will be tossed.
12. Each team needs to keep score in your teams scorebook. Scores must be verified with other team kept in book for verification.
