Raymond Ice Arena Opening for the Season: Oct. 13

The Raymond Ice Arena reopens for the season on Tuesday, October 13.

Curbside Recycling Beginning October 2026

Raymond's new curbside recycling program begins rolling out in October, with collection starting in two zones:

- **Tuesday, October 6:** Residences south of 200 St. N to 400 St. S, south of Hwy. 52, and west of Raymond Golf Course. This includes StoneGate Meadows.
- **Tuesday, October 13:** Residences north of 200 St. N and west of 400 St. E.

After the first collection, recycling will be collected every other Tuesday in each area.
