Service	Status	Details
Town Office		Closed to the public until further notice. The office will, however, be open by phone during normal business hours (8:30am-12pm, 1pm-4:30pm). Bill payments can be done online through your bank or you can set up a pre-authorized payment with the Town. If there are circumstances that necessitate an in-person meeting, it will be done by appointment only. Please call ahead to request and complete the required self-assessment form that will be emailed to you. Questions, please call 403-752-3322, then option 1.
Council Meetings		Regular Council meetings will continue as scheduled with limited public participation. Please call the office to confirm your attendance and to have the required self-assessment form emailed to you. You will be required to complete the self-assessment form and provide us with a signed copy prior to entry into the Council meeting. All but essential committee meetings have been cancelled.
Town Shop		Closed to the public. If you have need to speak with operations, please dial 403-752-3121
Playgrounds		Playgrounds are closed to the public.
Parks		Our parks and trail system remain open. No gatherings of 15 or more people are permitted. People using the park system should try to maintain proper social distancing.
Recreation Programs		All programs have been suspended until April 15th. If Provincial restrictions continue after the 15th, refunds will be issued for any programs that you have been registered in. For more information, visit Raymond Recreation .
Town Events		All events are cancelled for the remainder of the month. The Southern Alberta Summer Games have been cancelled for this year. Decisions about future events (Heritage Days, Stampede, etc.) will be finalized on May 5th.
VSP Fitness		Closed until further notice.
Library		The Library is closed until further notice. You can still access many Library services online .
Broadway Theatre		Closed until further notice.
Community Centre		Closed until further notice. However, those businesses which lease office space will still be able to operate their businesses out of the Community Centre.
