TOWN OF RAYMOND BYLAW NO. 1103-21

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF RAYMOND TO ESTABLISH AND DEFINE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS it is provided in Section 145 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, that Council may pass bylaws to establish council committees and define their functions;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to establish a council committee to assist Council with engaging the public during the Council decision making process;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RAYMOND, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

PART 1 - INTERPRETATION

1. This Bylaw may be referred as the "Community Engagement Committee Bylaw".

PART 2 – APPLICATION

2. This Bylaw applies to issues related to engaging the public in the decision-making process for the Council of the Town of Raymond.

PART 3 - DEFINITIONS

- 3. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) "Town" means the municipal corporation of the Town of Raymond or the area contained within the boundaries of the Town.
 - (b) "Committee" means the Community Engagement Committee established by this Bylaw.
 - (c) "Council" means the municipal council of the Town of Raymond.
 - (d) "Interested party" means an individual or group specifically invited by the Committee to attend a specified Committee meeting to address a specific item on the Committee's agenda.

PART 4 – MEMBERSHIP

- 4. The Committee shall consist of two (2) Town Councillors and no more than six (6) members at large.
 - (a) Members at large will serve on the committee for a term not to exceed two (2) years.

- (b) Members at large wishing to serve beyond a two-year term can re-apply for membership. When there are more applications than vacancies, new applicants will be given priority over returning applicants.
- 5. (a) The Committee Chair will be a Town Councillor appointed to the Committee. Appointment will occur yearly at the Council Organizational meeting.
- 6. The Committee will designate by resolution one (1) member as Vice Chair annually following Council Organizational Meeting.
- 7. The Committee shall meet as required at the call of the Chair. If the Chair is unwilling or unable to call a meeting of the Committee, any member of Council may request that Council, by resolution, call a meeting of the Committee.
- 8. The Chair shall, in ensuring that the Committee fulfills its roles and responsibilities as defined in this Bylaw, undertake the following:
 - (a) Schedule and chair Committee meetings;
 - (b) Approve agendas for Committee meetings in consultation with administration;
 - (c) Liaise with administration; and
 - (d) Report to Council on behalf of the Committee.
- 9. The Committee Chair may invite or accept requests from interested parties to attend Committee meetings to make verbal presentations or to make written submissions to the Committee on a specific item on the Committee's agenda.
- 10. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to Council on Town engagement related issues, including but not limited to:
 - (a) evaluating the level, method and circumstances under which citizens should be involved in the municipal decision-making process
 - (b) Enhancing the transparency of municipal decision making
 - (c) Growing public engagement in municipal matters
 - (d) Engagement issues as requested by Council from time to time
