Board Type and Mandate

The Oldman River Regional Services Commission (ORRSC) Assessment Review Board is a legislative board that hears assessment appeals from property owners. Its mandate is to review assessment appeals and determine whether amendments to assessment reports are warranted.

Board Timeframe, Reporting, and Deadlines

The ORRSC Assessment Review Board meets when it receives an appeal from a property owner. If there are no appeals submitted, it does not meet.

Board Composition

The ORRSC Assessment Review Board is composed of a minimum of twenty members, some of whom are members of the general public and some of whom are elected officials.
