Committee Type and Mandate

The Truth and Reconciliation Committee is an ad hoc committee formed to make a set of recommendations to Council on best practices/action items for rebuilding trust and maintaining respectful, productive relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous members of the community, as well as between the Town and its Indigenous counterparts.

Committee Timeframe, Reporting, and Deadlines

The Truth and Reconciliation Committee will meet as many times as it deems necessary during its one (1) year term and will report to Council with a final list of recommendations before the end of their one (1) year term.
