WHAT IS THE STIRLING WIND PROJECT?

The Stirling Wind Project is a wind power plant owned by Stirling Renewable Energy Limited Partnership (SRELP), a partnership between Potentia Renewables and Paul First Nation that is located 8 km northeast of the town of Stirling, Alberta. The Stirling Wind Project I will include 23 wind turbines and associated infrastructure and will have a generation capacity of 113 MW.

Site mobilization and civil construction for the Stirling Wind Project will start at the beginning of May 2022. Additional details on the construction activities and schedule will be presented at the open house.
